When It's Cold Outside, Stay Safe and Warm Inside

Whether you're using a fireplace, furnace, wood stove or space heater in your home, we offer the following safety tips:

- Keep a three-foot clearance between all heating equipment and anything that can burn (such as furniture and drapes).
- Never use your oven to heat your home.
- Turn off portable space heaters when leaving a room and before going to bed.
- Make sure your fireplace has a sturdy screen to prevent sparks from flying into the room.
- Have heating equipment inspected and cleaned every year.
- Install smoke alarms and carbon monoxide alarms.

Finance Programs for Solar Energy Projects Coming Soon

Residential and business customers of Atlantic City Electric interested in generating electricity by installing solar energy projects on their property will be getting financial support from the utility in the coming years.

In response to an order by the Board of Public Utilities (BPU), Atlantic City Electric recently filed a proposal to purchase solar renewable energy certificates - or SRECs - under long-term contracts with project owners installing new solar installations in Atlantic City Electric Company's service territory.

The BPU believes that this type of SREC financing program will meet a state goal of encouraging the growth of solar energy generation projects within New Jersey.

The utility's filing aligns with the state's Renewable Portfolio Standards (RPS), which requires that 20 percent of the state's electricity come from renewable sources by the year 2020.

SRECs are tradable certificates that represent the clean energy benefits of electricity generated from a solar electric system. Each time a solar electric system generates 1,000 kilowatt-hours of electricity, that customer receives an SREC that can then be sold or traded on the wholesale energy market.

In addition to this filing, the company in its "Blueprint for the Future Filing" proposed an interest rate buydown program to assist customers in obtaining loans at below market interest rates to install a solar electric system on their home or business.

- Let the sun heat your home – open curtains and drapes during the day, but close them at night to keep the chill out.
- Test your windows and doors for air tightness, add weather stripping and caulk where necessary.
- Set your thermostat at 68 degrees during the day and 60 degrees at night, health permitting.
- Turn the thermostat down to 60 degrees if you will be away from home for four hours or more.

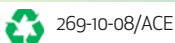
