I further certify that the applicant satisfies the requirements for this service set out in N.J.S.A. 48:2-21.41 because it is an organization dedicated to serving the needs of veterans of the armed forces that is (1) chartered under federal law; (2) qualified as a tax exempt organization under section 501 of the federal Internal Revenue Code; or (3) organized as a nonprofit corporation under the New Jersey Nonprofit Corporation Act. As proof of eligibility, I attach one of the following: the organization's Federal charter; a State of New Jersey "Exempt Organization Certificate" Form ST-5; or an Internal Revenue Service Determination Letter stating that the organization is exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c) (19) of the Internal Revenue Code.

I understand that the submission of either of the documents specified in the above paragraph will not guarantee eligibility and that, upon request by Atlantic City Electric, I shall furnish further satisfactory proof of eligibility for service under this Special Provision.

I understand that I must notify Atlantic City Electric if the primary use of the location is no longer related to the veterans' organization identified above. I understand that Atlantic City Electric may make inspections at any time to determine if the property is the location where the veteran's organization primarily operates.

I certify that all information given in the Application is correct and that any accompanying documents are true copies.

## **Residential Rate Credit for Veterans' Organizations - Frequently Asked Questions**

### **What is it?**

*On August 10, 2018, Governor Philip D. Murphy signed a bill into law permitting a veterans'-organization to receive a residential rate for utility service delivered to the property at which the veterans'-organization primarily operates if the residential rate is lower than the commercial rate for service delivered at that property.*

### **To which entities does the law apply?**

*The law applies to "veterans' organizations," which the law defines as "an organization dedicated to serving the needs of veterans of the armed forces" and that also satisfies at least one of the following criteria (not all three): (1) is chartered under federal law; (2) qualifies as a tax exempt organization under paragraph (19) of subsection (c) of section 501 of the Federal Internal Revenue Code of 1986, 26 U.S.C. s.501 (c)(19); or (3) that is organized as a corporation under the "New Jersey Nonprofit Corporation Act," N.J.S.A.15A:1-1 et seq.*

*Please make sure to include with your application document(s) demonstrating your organization's eligibility, as described in the previous answer. Once received, a representative of Atlantic City Electric will contact you regarding your application and if your application is approved.*

### **I called Atlantic City Electric to apply for the benefit but was told that no application existed at the time of my call. When will my organization begin to receive the benefit?**

*Atlantic City Electric has been tracking the date veterans' organizations have contacted the Company to inquire about the benefit, before an application was available. Once the completed application and supporting documents are submitted and found eligible to receive the benefit, Atlantic City Electric will run the benefit retroactive to the first billing cycle that commences after the organization contacted Atlantic City Electric.*

### **How is the benefit applied?**

*Each month, during the billing process, a comparison will be made to the Residential rate schedule. If the Residential rate schedule is lower for the distribution portion of the bill, a credit will be placed on the customer's account. If the Residential rate is not lower, the customer will be billed under its applicable rate schedule and no corresponding credit will be placed on the customer's account.*

**Does the credit apply to both gas and electric service?**

*Atlantic City Electric does not distribute natural gas. The credit only applies to Atlantic City Electric’s electric delivery service. Check with your local gas distribution company to see if your organization qualifies.*

**Will the veterans’ organization be switched to a residential rate?**

*No. The veterans’ organization will remain on the applicable rate, and receive a credit for any difference described in the answer to the question “How is the benefit applied?”*

**What happens if the comparison shows that the residential rate schedule was higher than the applicable commercial rate during the review period? Will the veterans’ organization have to pay the higher residential rate?**

*No. The veterans’ organization will be billed at its applicable rate.*

**Will Atlantic City Electric look at my total bill when comparing the residential rate schedule charge to the commercial rate schedule charge?**

*No. Commodity/supply charges are not taken into consideration when Atlantic City Electric conducts the comparison; the credit applies only to the electric delivery service charges.*

**Can my organization receive the credit at multiple locations?**

*A completed application and supporting documents are required to be submitted and reviewed for eligibility for each location requesting the benefit.*

**Does the veterans’ organization need to recertify or requalify itself at any point to continue receiving the credit?**

*No. The organization will continue to receive the credit -- as long as it remains eligible for the credit under the criteria described above.*

**What happens if the location for which the organization receives the credit is no longer used to serve veterans’ interests?**

*It is the veterans’ organization’s responsibility to advise Atlantic City Electric as soon as practicable if the primary use of the location receiving the credit is no longer related to serving veterans’ interests.*

**Will Atlantic City Electric do any sort of verification to determine the purpose of the location receiving the credit?**

*Atlantic City Electric reserves the right to make inspections to determine if the property where the account is located is the location where the veterans’ organization primarily operates.*
